Finally, I believe (just before Summer officially starts). real Spring has finally arrived, and what a wonder it is. The flowers are gorgeous this year; and the mulberry bushes are loaded with fruit. Oh, the promise of Spring, the promise of new blessings rising out of yesterday’s winters!

**During the last 3 months,** I experienced some brand new things. First, it was my privilege to be officially “commissioned”, set apart, prayed over and “sent” by my dear covering church family and pastor at Covenant Christian Church in Belle Vernon, PA. I am doing another Arise With Praise Seminar, two church camps in Michigan, three denominational conventions, and altogether 10 women’s retreats. **There are still openings for ministry in my schedule, and I’d love to minister to your group or church if you would so desire. stretched. I have gone more than once back to the original drawing board:

1. Has God called me to this ministry? Yes!

*He is looking for Praise, He promises if we will praise him, the earth will release our increase and He will bless us. That means that no matter what you are going through today, just praise Him with all that is within you, just praise Him. When we can praise Him through our trials and tribulations, this lets Daddy know that nothing really matters except Him. **This is a step of faith praising Him before we can see the outcome.** But when we are in intimate relationship with Him, it doesn't matter what comes our way. If it came God allowed it to either do a work in us or for us. Let it work today and stop whatever you are doing and let us give the Lord a crazy praise, just because He is worthy.*
