

Recommended Book of the month: Set Apart for God by John Mulinde

I've been teaching on the call of God to be set apart for Him as discussed by the author mentioned above, Rev. John Mulinde.

It is interesting to consider that whenever God wants to do something in a person, he calls him or her to be set apart so that His plans and purposes can come to fruition in that person's life. What does it mean to be set apart? It really means two things:

- 1) to be set apart **for** – that means to be singled out by God **for** a specific purpose of His heart.
- 2) to be set apart **from** – this means to be separated from those things within us that would hinder or contaminate God's plans for a person. When one is set apart **from** – then God will act and do wonderful things to the glory of His name.

When I consider this call, this challenge to accept God's invitation to be set apart for Him, I cannot but know in my "knower" that there are things in me – that have not yet been fully surrendered to Him. He continues to call me to a deeper surrender which flows out of whatever level of trust I have in Him, and whether my love for Him is greater than my love for whatever He has shown me within that competes with Him for my attention and affection.
